

NECESSARY INFORMATION BEFORE COMING TO SPAIN

VISAS

- Citizens of the European Union are not required to get a visa for any of the European Union countries.
- Non- EU students must address all questions concerning requirements for getting a visa to the Spanish Consulate or Embassy nearest to their residence.
- The *Official Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Soria Province* can draw up a letter of invitation to all those students whose visa application requires it.

INSURANCES

- Students from EU countries, if they have social security coverage from their home country, they must obtain the European Health Insurance Card before coming and bring it to Spain to be entitled to free medical treatment in accordance with the Spanish Social Security. If they have no social security coverage from their home country, they should ask their private health insurance company for medical treatment in Spain.
- Students from countries outside the EU must have a health insurance policy at their home country that covers them abroad.
- The International School of Soria provides all the students with a Civil Liability Insurance¹ for their stay at our center.

MINOR STUDENTS

- Minor students must bring a consent form signed by their parents if they want to they take part in some of the out-of-school activities. If not, they will not be able to participate in any of the school activities taking place out of Soria.

¹ Civil Liability Insurance contracted by The *Official Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Soria Province* would cover any incident that occurred at the center.
